

This long-awaited book, a history of this part of Alberta and especially about the hospital at Lamont, has now been printed and is available at the Lamont Health Care Centre. It traces the development of hospital facilities in Lamont, and includes several chapters about the School of Nursing as well as stories about building projects to house the hospital and staff.

The book also contains a new account of the November 29, 1960 train-schoolbus accident at Lamont. It pays tribute to the outstanding effort of doctors, nurses, hospital staff and hundreds of people from Lamont and surrounding places who made a valiant effort to save the lives of as many students as possible. There is picture and brief story of each one of the seventeen High School Students who died of injuries in the accident.

Stories of the earliest settlement of this land and the courage of those who chose to help make this country what it is, and stories of early health care initiatives leading to medicare's development all contribute to this book's rich tapestry of local history.
